Membership reminders:

Do not use this renewal form as a new member application form.

Many members seem to be confused when they should renew. Renewals start in December and need to be received prior to January 31st to not have a break in range access. Late renewals will be accepted but can take up to 2 months to be processed. All members must present their current membership card to other members if requested while on TSC property.

Changes for 2023:

A new Rule Violation Policy will start in 2023. Depending on the severity and other factors rule violations will carry penalties including fines, remedial range orientation class, and membership revocation with a lifetime ban. The flyer with your 2023 card will include the Rule Violation Policy. If you observe any rule violations or have questions contact the secretary.

Rules 1, 17, and 27 have been updated with new content. As with all the rules, read them, know them, and follow them.

<<UPDATED>> Rule 1: We have zero tolerance for being under the influence of alcohol or drugs at the range.

<<UPDATED>> Rule 17: Shotguns are only allowed on the trap, skeet and multipurpose ranges.

<<UPDATED>> Rule 27: Updated to address the firing line (red) and cease fire line (yellow) on the pistol and rifle ranges. You can be in front of the red line or behind the yellow line during a cease fire but not between them.

Club meetings are held once a month except during December. See the club website for the location and time of the monthly meetings. All members are encouraged to attend and participate in the operation and administrating our Club.

The combination to the range entrance gate is changed annually at the end of February. Your membership card will have the new four-digit combination. Please lock gate and thoroughly scramble combination after entering and when leaving. Membership is subject to agreement to adhere to and continued adherence to basic safety rules and to the Club Rules printed on the reverse side of this form. Your renewal will rejected if you do not sign at the bottom of the rules page.

Rangemasters are authorized by the board directors to enforce all club rules and safety regulations.

2023 Tehachapi Sportsman Club Range Rules

1. Being under the influence of alcohol or mind-altering drugs is not allowed on range premises.
2. Everyone on the range must obey the basic safety rules and all club rules.
3. All shooters under the age of 18 must be under the direct supervision of an adult who must be present with the shooter at the immediate shooting station.
4. All firearms must be brought onto and off the range in an unloaded condition. Law enforcement officers and holders of a valid CCW permit are exempt from this rule.
5. Members are responsible for the actions of their guests and must accompany their guest for the entire time they are present at the range.
6. Members are never permitted to give the range lock combination to anyone.
7. Members will clean up after using the range and will leave the range in as good or better condition than it was found.
8. When entering the range, be sure to raise the red flag and lock the gate.
9. When leaving the range, the last person to leave will lower the red flag and lock the gate.
10. The gate may only be left open when manned by a range master or club officer. If left open there will be a 100% check for valid membership at the gate. Check for a current membership card for anyone following you through the gate.
11. Bottles, cans, metallic or other non-standard targets are not allowed at any time.
12. Firing at rocks either on the ground or berms, or any object on the hillside is not allowed.
13. Do not attach targets over a vertical or horizontal support. Use only the backboard material between the supports.
14. Do not place targets on the ground.
15. Stationary clay targets are permitted on the MPR ONLY and must be placed on the berms. Placement must be at least 4 feet from the top of the berm.
16. Live ammunition may not be disposed of in the trashcans.
17. Rifles chambered in .22LR are allowed on the pistol range. Shotguns are not allowed on the pistol or rifle ranges.
18. All shooters will temporarily cease fire whenever anyone is down range or on the north side of our property, from our back fence to the top of the hill beyond. Consider the range closed if this area is occupied by anyone.
19. The only size of shot allowed on the Trap and Skeet ranges is #7 ½ or smaller.
20. Fully automatic firearms are permitted for law enforcement training only by prior approval by a vote of the membership at a regular monthly meeting.
21. Armor piercing, incendiary ammunition, as well as projectiles containing any steel are not allowed to be fired on the range.
22. No vandalism of any kind will be tolerated.
23. Any person found violating basic safety rules and/or club rules will be given a hearing by the board. This hearing may result in a dismissal from the club or loss of club privileges for a period of time deemed by the board to be appropriate to the violation.
24. All firearms will be pointed down range at all times.
25. Cross range shooting is not permitted.
26. Before using the pistol ranges or MPR, check for people at the 200 and 300 yard rifle ranges. Before using the MPR check for people at the 100 yard rifle range. Do not start shooting until these ranges are clear and people are back at the firing line.
27. A ten minute target marking period will be observed every half hour when multiple shooters occupy the range. The pistol ranges and multipurpose range must be checked and a cease fire called, before going down to the 200 and/or 300 yard targets. The multipurpose range must be checked and a cease fire called, before going down to the 100 yard rifle range targets. During a cease fire, all firing lines shall be closed and firearms must be unloaded, actions open, grounded or holstered, and no firearms will be handled. No lingering between the firing line and cease fire line during a cease fire. Upon returning to the firing line, inform all shooters that the range is open.
28. Only arrows or bolts are allowed on the archery range.
29. Be respectful of others. Criminal activity, being argumentative or disruptive, profanity, coarse or abusive language, and actions, will not be tolerated.
30. Members must use their own stands only at the multipurpose range, the stands must be made of wood or PVC and be at least 6 feet tall to ensure shots have the berm as a back stop. Only paper targets are allowed on the stands. Do not take stands from the pistol range to the MPR.

I hereby certify that I have read and understand the above rules. Furthermore, I agree to abide by and have all my guests abide by these rules at all times while at or using the club range. I certify that I am legally entitled to possess firearms in the State of California.
